—International Nuclear Information System (INIS)

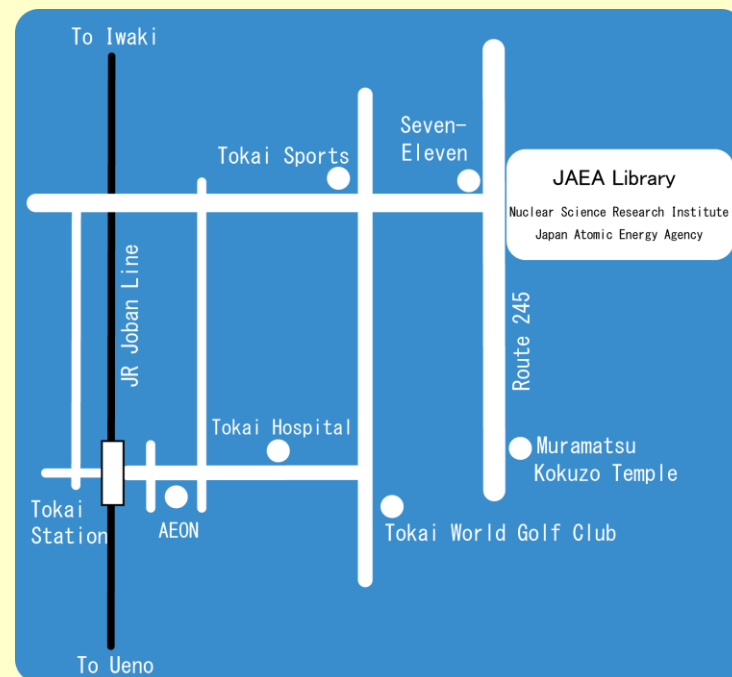
The **International Nuclear Information System (INIS)** was established in 1970 by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). The purpose of the **INIS** is fostering the exchange of scientific and technical information on peaceful uses of atomic energy. The **INIS** is operated by the IAEA in collaboration with the 130 member states and the 24 international organizations and the **INIS Database** contains about 3.8 million bibliographic records. The JAEA Library plays a role of the INIS National Center of Japan. We arrange the bibliographic records about nuclear related literature published in Japan, and provide them to the **INIS Database**. Besides, we make effort to promote utilizations of the **INIS Database** in Japan. The **INIS Database** is opened to the all Internet users around the world. The **INIS Database** via the Internet has been enhanced, called “**INIS Repository Search**”, with similar search functions to Google™ Search. Free, open and unrestricted access is available from the JAEA Library’s Website.

—International Nuclear Library Network (INLN)

The **International Nuclear Library Network (INLN)** is a global nuclear knowledge management initiative aiming to strengthen international cooperation. Research institutes and libraries in the nuclear field are invited to join the **INLN** and enjoy premium services. The JAEA library participates in the **INLN**, and the participating libraries help each other with inter-library-loans, reference services etc. using the Internet-based library and information system.

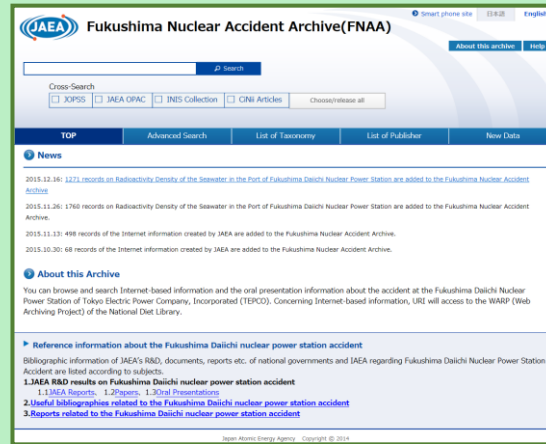

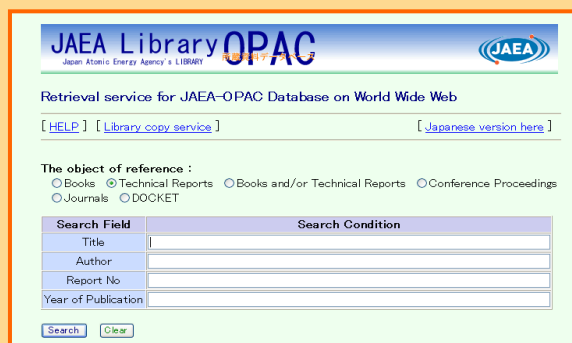

The **Fukushima Nuclear Accident Archive** provides information on the Internet and bibliographic information of oral presentations related to the accident at the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station of the Tokyo Electric Power Company. Information of the Internet has links to the **Web Archiving Project (WARP)** of the National Diet Library. The list of the R&D results related to the Fukushima Accident by the JAEA staffs and the useful bibliographies related to the TMI-2, the Chernobylsk-4 reactor accidents and environmental decontamination etc. are also available.

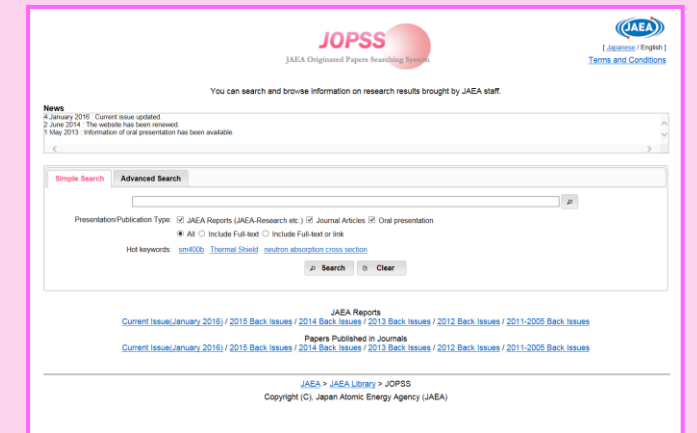

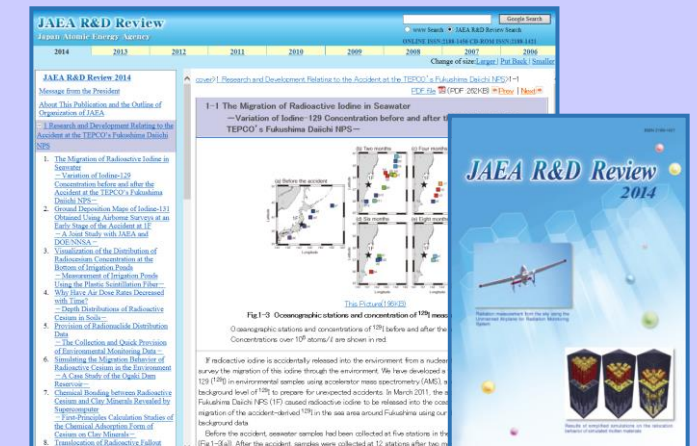
JOPSS

(JAEA Originated Papers Searching System)



The JAEA creates about 200 JAEA Reports ("JAEA-Research" etc.) and about 1,800 papers contributing to scientific journals every year. Bibliographic data and abstracts of these about 93,000 research results are available through the **JOPSS** as a retrieval system by keywords. The **JOPSS** enables you to search and browse information on Knowledge base of the JAEA research results, in addition full-text (PDF Formats) of the JAEA Reports.
